MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS 2015

Municipal Elections will be held **on 24 May, 2015**. These elections **are open to all citizens who are not Spanish and who are nationals of other European Union countries residing in;** and **NACIONALES DE PAÍSES CON ACUERDO DE RECIPROCIDAD: Bolivia, Cabo Verde, Chile, Colombia, Corea, Ecuador, Islandia, Noruega, Nueva Zelanda, Paraguay, Perú, Trinidad y Tobago.**

In order to be included on the electoral roll, it is necessary for you to be included in the “Padrón Municipal” (municipal register) where you habitually live, as was set out by Articles 15 and 18 of the Law 4/1996 of 10 January regarding regulation of the local system. This in itself does not allow you to exercise your right to vote. Being on the municipal register is no sufficient as **you have to express your wish to vote in Spain.**

At Alcúdia town hall’s Department of Statistics and Population, which is located in the Passeig de Pere Ventayol, number 4, they will advise citizens of the EU and LOS CIUDADANOS NACIONALES CON ACUERDO DE RECIPROCIDAD, who are enrolled on the municipal register of the steps to take for inclusion on the electoral roll and so exercise their right to vote.
